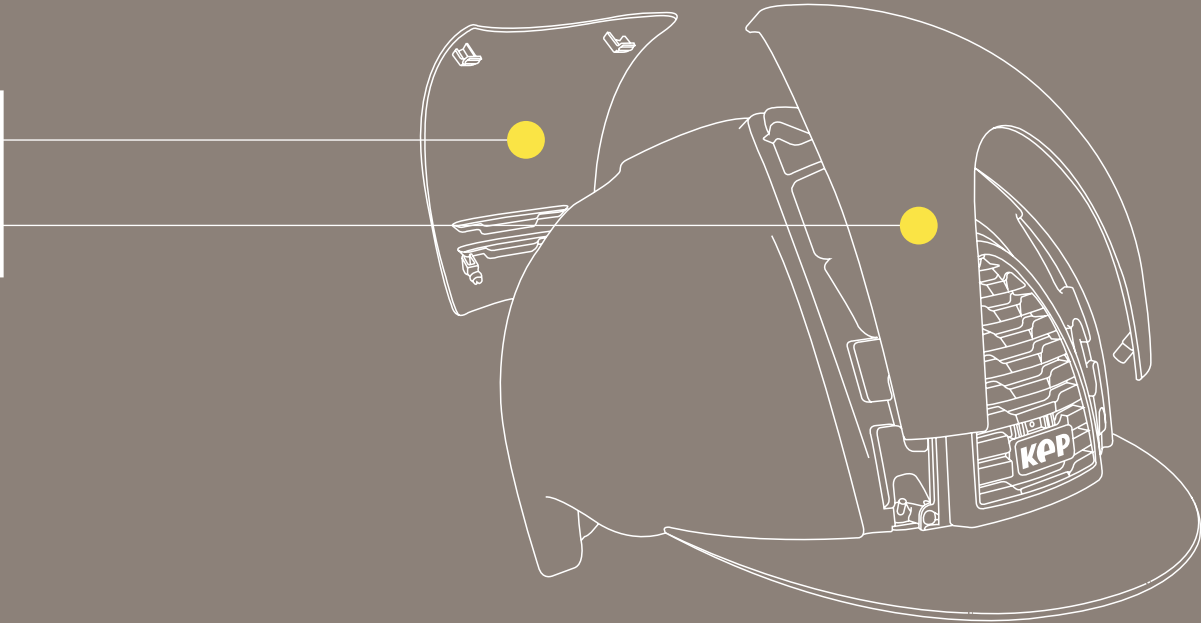
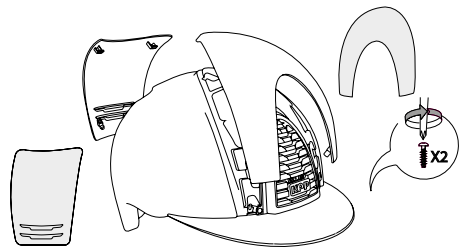

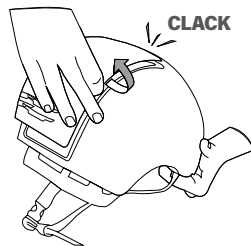




## REPLACING THE PANELS

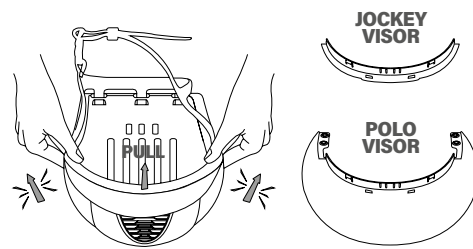
### FRONT

- remove padding and visor
- unscrew the screws of the front panel
- unhook the panel from the sides
- put in the new panel taking care to set the hooks in place
- fix with screws and set visor and padding back in place



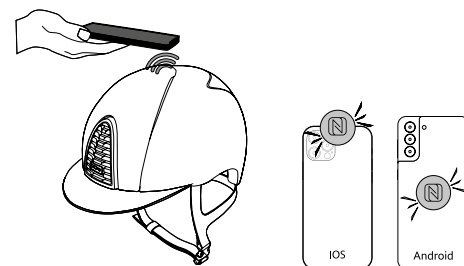
### REAR

- remove the back panel by holding its lower side and lifting upwards
- set the new panel taking care to set the hooks in place and press the lower part towards the shell until you hear a click



## REPLACING OR REMOVING THE VISOR

- lift the visor upwards to release it
- place the polo visor by exerting pressure until it adheres completely to the shell - feeling it click and use a flat screwdriver to fix the existing screws
- to completely remove the visor you need to insert the jockey visor supplied to secure the internal padding



## APP E NFC

A CHIP placed under the front panel and integrated NFC technology improve and make more efficient first aid procedures. The NFC device is connected to the Kep App, where the rider can download health information and the Green Pass certification. Rescue workers will consequently have easy access to information by placing a mobile device near the helmet.
